My dear Bishop -

is all that we are concerned with, and
we pay less taxes. But according to the documents
I have here of different purchases there
should be a considerable number of acres
more than appear on the map.

I have a suspicion that his mathematics
have been based on the documents that
Parra-Capó has, while fortunately I found
several of them that he has not, and
I am sending them to him now.
