Dear Bishop:

Mrs. Wheaton, a representative from the Woman's Auxiliary of the Second Province, will arrive in San Juan on Monday, May 5th. I do not know how long she expects to remain, but fear that she may expect to sail for St. Thomas on Thursday, the 8th.

With the above dates in view, I am arranging to take Mrs. Wheaton on an itinerary as follows:

Leave San Juan Tuesday morning; arrive in Ponce for lunch.
Leave Ponce Wednesday morning, early, for Quebrada Limon.
Leave Quebrada Limon at noon for Mayaguez.
Leave Mayaguez Thursday morning for Manati; arrive at El Coto for lunch.
Reach San Juan at six p. m.; Sail for St. Thomas at 9 p. m. of Thursday. (Mrs. Wheaton sails, not I).

Will you kindly take note of the above and make arrangements for me to show Mrs. Wheaton all that I can of the work under your charge in the short time allotted to us? This is the first time any representative of the Woman's Auxiliary has visited Porto Rico, and I hope that her visit may be a favorable one.
