My dear Bishop:

I am enclosing your license receipt from the State of New Jersey, together with two application blanks for license as operator in Porto Rico. The yellow blank is for a thirty days' license and I am informed will cost \$8.00, and, after the thirty days, has to be renewed. The green blank is for a permanent license, which I would, personally, advise you to take, instead of the temporary one.

Ordinarily one has to take <sup>an</sup> apprentice license for two months, but you are excused from this, in as much as you have the New Jersey operator's license. You are, however, required to take the examination, as is everyone else, and I am informed that no one is excused from this. You can take the examination in San Juan on, practically, any day, or you may apply to the Chief of Police in Pence, to find out at what time you may take the examination there. Am sorry that I can give you no more satisfactory answer than the above.

In as much as you, Fr. Saylor and I have to be in Pence on Thursday night, I have called a meeting of the Executive Council for Friday morning at nine o'clock, that we may take advantage of the opportunity.
