My dear Bishop Ferrando:

As regards the deduction of 6% from your salary, as agreed upon at the meeting of the Executive Council, I want to explain the method adopted in making payments during the remainder of this year.

The total appropriation for your salary is	\$2,500.00
From which there has been deducted	150.00
Leaving a balance for the year 1928 of	<u>\$2,350.00</u>
Of this amount you were paid in January	208.33
Which leaves for the remaining 11 months	<u>\$2,141.67</u>

Or \$194.69 per month.

I certainly appreciate deeply the way the American clergy have all so generously accepted the deduction from their salaries and I certainly hope that this will prove of value to the Field Department in their arguments before the general Church and hope also that it will make a difference in the pledges for the year 1929.
