

Sunday, Sept 18th 1932.

My dear Bishop:

Have just returned from Ponce where I consulted Gustavo Rodriguez again and he showed me the expediente no 105 of Descartes, that it is a "carta de pago" but has not been registered. ^{now is it the deed to the property.} This is the deed you gave me in May when I visited you and we are using it in the papers which will be filed with the Registrar. Everything is in readiness now for completion of the papers with the reception of the ratification by the Board of Trustees of the Church of Jesus of your purchase of the land for them, in the form I sent you from Gustavo Rodriguez. I would greatly appreciate it if you will get that attended to in the proper legal manner, before a notary, and send to me by air mail. As soon as we have that, we can proceed with the transfer to the Domestic & Foreign Missionary Society. I am hurrying now to take this to San Juan, and put it in the air mail.
