I am sending you an estimate of the monthly expenses of St. Marc's Mission Church.

- Rent of building used for service - \$25.00
  - Salary of organist - 10.00
  - \* Salary of janitor - 5.00
  - \* Oil for lamps - 1.00
  - \* Candles for altar - .10
  - \* Bread and wine - probably - .10
  - \* Washing altar linens, about - .50
  - sums used in decorating, Easter, Christmas and Thanksgiving. 1.50 - .15
  - lamp wicks and chimneys - about - .25
  - brooms & dusters - " - .15
  - paint for chancel twice a year \$3.00 - .25  
(the janitor does the painting)
- \$ 42.50

\$47.00 would allow a margin for alms, and for unforeseen expenses. The alms have been \$200 in times of much sickness. To this \$47.00 should be added the expense of a visiting clergyman.

Present expenses of school. Monthly -

- Salaries of 3 teachers, \$18.00 each - - - \$ 54.00
  - Salary of pupil teacher - - - 6.00
  - Janitor's work - - - 6.00
  - Taxes on casita, \$6.44 - - - .53 <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub>
  - water-rate - \$16.00 - - - 1.33 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub>
  - insurance \$31.00 - - - 2.58 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub>
  - school supplies - - - about 6.00
- \$ 76.45 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub>

I would like to make the salaries of the teachers each \$20.00 and that of the pupil teacher \$10.00, and put the school on a business basis, as far as that part is concerned. I am
