My dear Mr. Droste,

It gives me great pleasure to tell you that at
its meeting on May 8 the Executive Committee passed the
following resolution with regard to your appointment.

RESOLVED: That, in accordance with the re-
quest of Bishop Colmore, the Rev. F. J. Droste be
and hereby is regularly appointed as missionary in
Porto Rico with the understanding that all increases
in salary due to term of service shall date from
January 26, 1915, the time when he was advanced to
the Priesthood by Bishop Colmore. It is understood
that, in granting Mr. Droste and wife a furlough, their
domicile shall be considered New York City.
