Memo. for the Council of Advice:

Writing under date of November 21st in regard to the \$785. which Bishop Colmore borrowed from his current expense account in order to pay up certain back bills of St. Luke's Hospital, he says:

"I hope to use this occasion to try out the people of Ponce and determine how much interest they have in the institution. They ought to be willing to pay all the expense of these repairs, though I have my doubts. However I am going to put it up to them. My main difficulty now is in not being able to leave home much, and personally supervising a campaign in Ponce. If however we are able to accomplish anything in the matter, I believe the Board will be willing to cancel the obligation we have to pay back the amount of \$785. which we borrowed for current expenses last January. Please hold the matter up until I can determine what can be done at this juncture."
